
CURTAIN RAISER OF LEARNING MANAGEMENT PORTAL BY IBM


LLOYD MENTORSHIP PROGRAM (LMP) "DRISHTI"

Life Chain (Lloyd Supply Chain Club), Lloyd Business School has successfully organized a supply chain activity on 'Kanban System'. It all started in the early 1940s. The first Kanban system was developed by Taiichi Ohno (Industrial Engineer and Businessman) for Toyota automotive in Japan. 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





